Reading Response Sheet

To receive full credit for the reading responses, answer these questions:

1. Character(s): Who is in the story and what are their relationships to each other?
2. Setting: What is the place/time, environment, atmosphere of the story?
3. Background: What is important information that takes place before the story begins?
4. Conflict: What is the main problem in the story? What kind of conflict is it?
5. Plot: What is happening in the story? What is the story about? This happened, then this happened, and so on.
6. Resolution: How and when was the conflict resolved? What is a good or bad outcome?
7. Point of View: Who is telling or narrating the story? Is one of the characters acting as a narrator (first person), or is it as if someone is looking at them and telling what is going on (third person)?
8. In a paragraph, explain the theme of the story.
